Hey there!

My name is Alyssa!! I'm a Minneapolis wedding photographer and the artist behind Alyssa Lund Photography.

In the summertime, I'm all about sunny state park hikes and an outdoor patio happy hour with friends. In the winter, I live in a nest of blankets and thrive off of bread-baking season (my partner Tyler makes the world's tastiest homemade pizza crust).

I am an optimist, a feminist, an art designer, and a photographer.

Most days you can find me with a giant mug of coffee editing pictures in my little office, and I feel super dang lucky that making art with amazing couples is my job. The things I'm most passionate about in life are probably my people (my family, my partner, my best buddies) and also that homemade pizza I mentioned earlier, because friends, it really is delicious.

I've been taking pictures for as long as I have memories, and I got my start in professional photography during college when I shot wedding during the summers. A decade later, my photography business is my full-time job and I couldn't be happier to do this for a living.

What sets me apart?

Kind, practical help along the way

All of my wedding packages start with a personal chat about your vision for your wedding day, how you want to look and feel in your portraits and how we can create emotionally rich photos that will instantly bring you back to all the feelings in this season of your life together.

From there we'll choose what your package needs to include, from hours of wedding day coverage, to engagement sessions, to beautiful printed art (digital files are always included.)

All the nerdy technical details

I've been a professional photographer since 2010 and have been doing this full-time since 2015. I bring the tools, know-how and photography gear to make sure that you get beautiful images, no matter the venue, vibe, or lighting situation.

Relationships (and your photos) as art

I am so passionate about creating tangible printed art with your wedding and engagement photos. I believe (it's kind of sappy) that when you're able to look at your portrait as a significant, heirloom piece of art every day, you begin to see yourself and your marriage as artful.

All of my wedding packages culminate in an heirloom wedding album that tells the story of your wedding day, and many of my couples also love to add on wall art (gallery walls, a favorite framed portrait, or even large-format art) and I love it all. I'll consult with you on design, printing your photos on archival paper and even hanging your art in your home.

you are *welcome* here

The wedding industry is not always an inclusive place, especially for people and couples who have been marginalized or whose existence has been ignored or underrepresented. I'm a person who carries a lot of privilege - I'm a white, cisgendered woman married to a man. I do my best to recognize and acknowledge my privilege, and use it to create a space that is as welcoming and inclusive as possible for the individuals and couples that I work with.

I believe Black Lives Matter. I welcome interracial couples and I'll photograph you regardless of your religion, race, cultural or ethnic background, citizenship status, gender identification, or physical ability. I'm a body-positive feminist and welcome people of all body shapes and sizes, and couples of all ages.

Looking for a wedding photographer who is part of the LGBTQIA+ community? I identify as bisexual! I hold a lot of privilege with this identity because I'm also in

a heterosexual marriage, so most folks assume that I'm straight. I've learned that knowing I'm bi has helped some couples feel really safe and welcome in working with me as a wedding photographer, so I try to let every couple I work with know that I will accept you and your partner as you are.

I'm an LGBTQIA+ friendly wedding photographer. I welcome trans folks and gender non-binary folks in my couples/wedding parties/etc. I try not to assume gender roles for my couples - I'll get to know you and your partner, so we can choose emotions poses and moments that reflect your own body language and relationship dynamics - whatever they may be.

Overall, I do my best to be an inclusive wedding photographer. You deserve to be validated and seen, to feel safe, and to be celebrated without judgement. I'm here to tell your story with love and respect.





wedding day timeline

A wedding day can be a whirlwind of moments and emotions, and a lot of the couples I work with worry that their wedding photography will be another potentially stressful element in an already busy day.

I've always been a little nerdy about organization, and as a wedding photographer this means I plan in advance to ensure that your wedding photography is stress-free and

a lovely part of your wedding day. I work closely with my clients to evaluate the parts of their wedding day they are most excited about, and together we design a custom photography timeline that fits their vision and priorities.

Curious what I'm up to during a wedding day? Here's an example of a typical wedding timeline.

Curious what I'm up to during a wedding day? Here's an example of a typical wedding timeline for eight hours of photography coverage.

1:00 getting ready

My second-shooter and I arrive and capture atmospheric and detail shots, then document the finishing touches of hair and makeup, and the couple getting dressed and hanging out with their wedding party.

1:30 first look

The couple sees each other for the first time and shares a little moment together, then we'll usually move into some happy couple portraits around your venue.

2:15 wedding party

The couple meets up with their wedding party and we'll get some pictures of all their people together and being happy!

3:00 family portraits

Pre-ceremony family portraits mean that makeup is fresh and coordination is a breeze. I will capture images with your most important family members (typically immediate families and grandparents).

3:30 downtime

The couple takes some time to regroup before the excitement begins. I'll arrive at the ceremony site to capture shots of the ceremony space and candid shots of your guests arriving.

4:00 ceremony

From emotional vows to the joyful recessional, during the ceremony, my second shooter and I will unobtrusively capture all the important moments.

4:30 cocktail hour

During your cocktail hour, I'm focusing on candid, emotional images of the couple greeting their family and friends, and guests enjoying themselves.

6:00 dinner and toasts

I usually try to enter the dining room before guests so that I can photograph reception decor and set up any needed equipment for the reception. As the couple and their guests sit down to dinner, I'll continue capturing candid moments and will be ready to document toasts and spontaneous moments throughout the evening.

7:30 sunset portraits

When the light turns golden and gorgeous outside, I often sneak outside with the couple to capture a few more happy, romantic portraits.

8:00 first dance

With my flashes and lighting equipment in place, I capture the first dance and the party that ensues, documenting the reception candidly as it unfolds.

9:00 wrap up

After some epic dancing pictures, I reach the end of my photography time. I'll pack up my equipment and prepare for my departure, checking in with the couple for any last-minute photo requests you have before I head off for the evening!

wedding albums

What to do with your pictures? A printed wedding album tells the story of your day.

A wedding album is the culmination of your wedding day memories. Most couples know they'd love to have a wedding album and I love keeping the process stress-free and simple, so you can be holding your album just weeks after your wedding.

I design each of my albums from scratch, working closely with you to create an album that relives the story of your wedding day. In fact, when you come to my home office just a few weeks after your wedding to see all of your wedding pictures, I will also have album mockup designs ready for you to see - we can make any changes you like, and then your album gets ordered right away and arrives just a

couple weeks after that. This means that just about a month after your wedding, you can be holding your wedding album in your hands.

Fine albums begin with pristine materials

I love all things tangible, and so I've put buckets of time into finding the perfect wedding album. These albums are my pride and joy, and they become prized possessions for my couples.

My albums are all made in the US, and they all start with beautiful, archival materials. The outside covers have tons of beautiful choices, from fine linens to luxurious rich leathers. These albums have lay-flat pages are made with real photographic paper and mounted onto super-thick sturdy board pages. The printed pages really make your images come to life, and they are rated to last for hundreds of years.

four reasons why I *love* engagement sessions

In most couples, at least one person isn't wild about having their picture taken, and this session lets you feel comfortable so you don't have to be nervous about photography on your wedding day.

As your photographer, it also gives me a chance to review your engagement pictures alongside you - we can talk about which pictures are your favorites. I take notes and keep those things in mind on your wedding day so that I can document you in your favorite light.

In a practical sense, it can be useful to have engagement pictures - they can be nice to add into a wedding website, or use for save the dates. And when couples want a portrait to hang on the wall, displaying an engagement portrait is a popular choice.

My last reason is the most emotional: I think it can just be lovely to have portraits of you and your partner in day-to-day life. I mean, you'll love your wedding pictures, but an engagement session reflects the dynamic of your relationship in an everyday, time-capsule kind of way.

What resonates with you and your relationship?

Neighborhood brewery

Make a date out of your engagement session! Breweries or coffee shops feel cozy and romantic while documenting a real place you love.

Sun-drenched field

Infuse natural beauty into your images with a sunlit summer evening, tall swaying grasses, and fields of wildflowers.

Local state park

Honor your epic relationship with an afternoon of hiking amid forests and trees. Bring your dog or a cozy blanket to cuddle up with!

Inside your home

Plan a relaxed lifestyle session for portraits that capture the everyday beauty of your love. Sip tea on the couch, get cozy under layers of blankets, dance while cooking in the kitchen.

Eliza & Isaac

When I first met Eliza and Isaac, it was instantly a wonderful meeting of minds, values and creative vision. During our initial phone conversation, Eliza and Isaac returned often to the idea of shaping their relationship with intention, of prioritizing an egalitarian partnership, of lending awareness to the gender roles that often influence relationships and remaking those into something that works for them. They were so mindful of how they wanted to spend their life together and so excited to share their wedding with their important people and communities. So basically, a lovely fit for the wedding stories I love to help tell!

Isaac loves the fall, and since they plan on getting married in the spring, they really wanted to capture autumn in the Twin Cities via their engagement portraits. As people whose relationship history included time apart, long-distance romance, and joining each other for big cross-country moves, Eliza and Isaac really wanted to use their portraits to capture and celebrate their bond together. They really prioritize being



close to each other, pursuing their own interests and activities in parallel, spending time enjoying their home and being self-reflective.

We chose the lovely scenery of Raspberry and Harriet Islands as the setting for these photos, I love the magical surprise of this tiny, beautiful bit of nature in the midst of the urban environment in St. Paul and it's the perfect backdrop for these cozy, mellow portraits that we took just after sunrise in the clear, golden light just following the dawn.



what to *expect*

The wedding photography process
with Alyssa Lund Photography

Booking

Initially, I meet up with couples in person (or via skype) to talk about what they're looking for with a wedding photographer, walk them through pricing and package options, and design a package that is custom-built around their needs.

Engagement

Engagement session planning begins with a chat about what you'd like to document in this chapter of your relationship, and together we'll plan the location/style/vibe of your pictures. I show you your portraits a week or two after their session.

Pre-wedding planning

Through your wedding-planning process, I can be here as a resource for you! From sharing vendor recommendations, to sketching out wedding-day timelines, to working directly with your day-of coordinator, I'm here to help in any way I can.

A few weeks before your wedding

We'll get together for a Final Details meeting to discuss your photography requests, wedding-day photography timeline, and final logistical details.

Wedding day

It's finally here! I'll arrive and dive into taking pictures as planned! You won't need to stress a bit - I have plans and backup plans in place, so you can focus on making memories, and I (and my second shooter, if your package includes one) will take care of capturing them.

One day after your wedding

I carefully backup your images in multiple places, Over the next weeks. I'll spend about 40 hours selecting, editing, and preparing your final wedding images, and creating a starting design for your wedding album.

1 month after your wedding

I'll invite you over to my home office for a reveal of all of your wedding pictures. We'll go through all the final images and plan out your wedding album and any other art you'd like to order. The reveal is one of my favorite parts of my job and is always really emotional and fun!

2-3 months after your wedding

Your wedding art is ready! My albums arrive about 2-8 weeks after your wedding reveal, and it is always SO exciting to see your album come to life!

wall art inspiration

What to do with your pictures? Put your favorite portraits on the wall.

So many of my couples will opt to add on some wall art in addition to their wedding album - whether it's a single beloved portrait or a trio of artistic images, it is so powerful and special to hang wedding or engagement portraits in your home.

A lot of couples like the idea of using their wedding pictures to create some art for their home, but aren't sure what form that might take. Would it include wedding portraits? Photos from their engagement session? Do they want single large photo or a collection of smaller ones?

With all these questions in mind, I actually visit most of my couples homes to do an art planning meeting. I love to sit with my

couples in their space, so we can talk about how they spend their time in their home and what they like to surround themselves with. I can see the colors and textures they're drawn to in their own home decor, and I always bring along samples of my art sizes and frame styles so we can see how those pieces would look in their space.

I know it can be really hard to picture the final result with printed art, so I use this really cool software program to take photos of my couple's walls and show them exactly what the different art designs or sizes will look like, to scale on their real walls.

From large-format canvases to custom frame gallery walls, I love working with couples to design a wall art collection with a style that will reflect their wedding atmosphere, showcase their favorite images, and fit in with their home decor.

While we certainly planned some posed photos of the wedding parties and families, the ones I love are the most "them," are these candid moments captured between locations as Susan and Brett joked with

their closest friends, drank a little beer and enjoyed a perfect day. How much do you love that photo of Susan in her beautiful dress, tall-boy in hand?

Their emotional ceremony

The wedding ceremony took place in the Arboretum's Sensory Garden, with dappled light and bright sun moving through the old trees. I loved witnessing how much Susan and Brett love each other: he cried at her vows, she at his. Pretty much everyone cried when they said "yes" to each other.

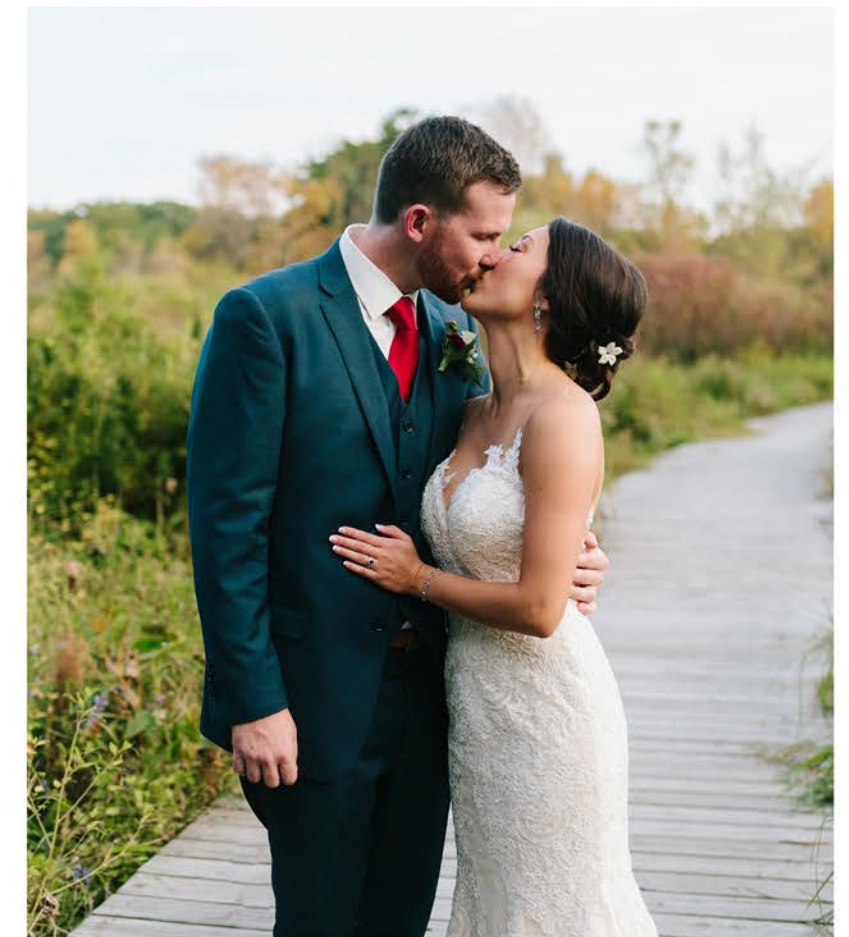
Sunset portraits in a field

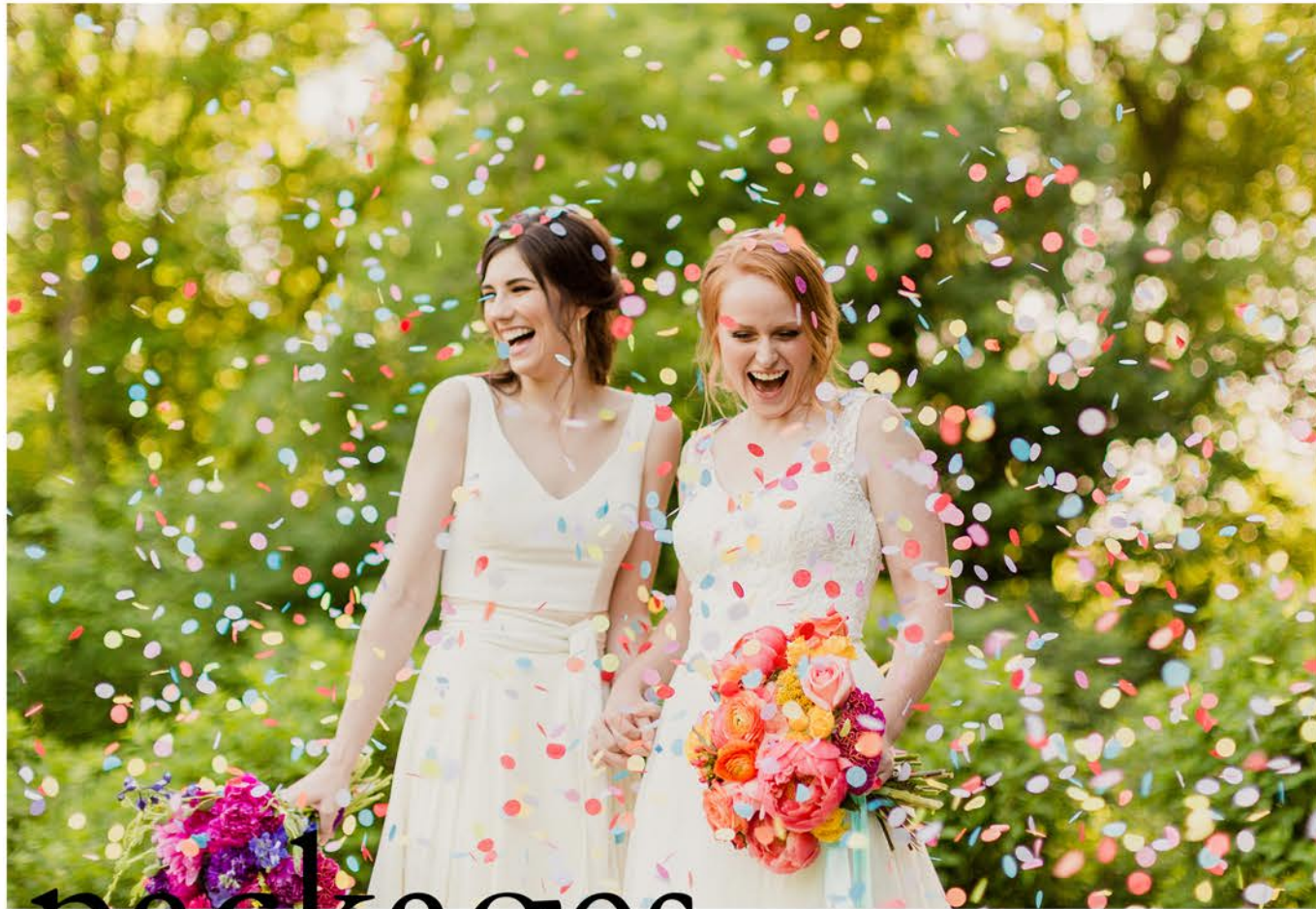

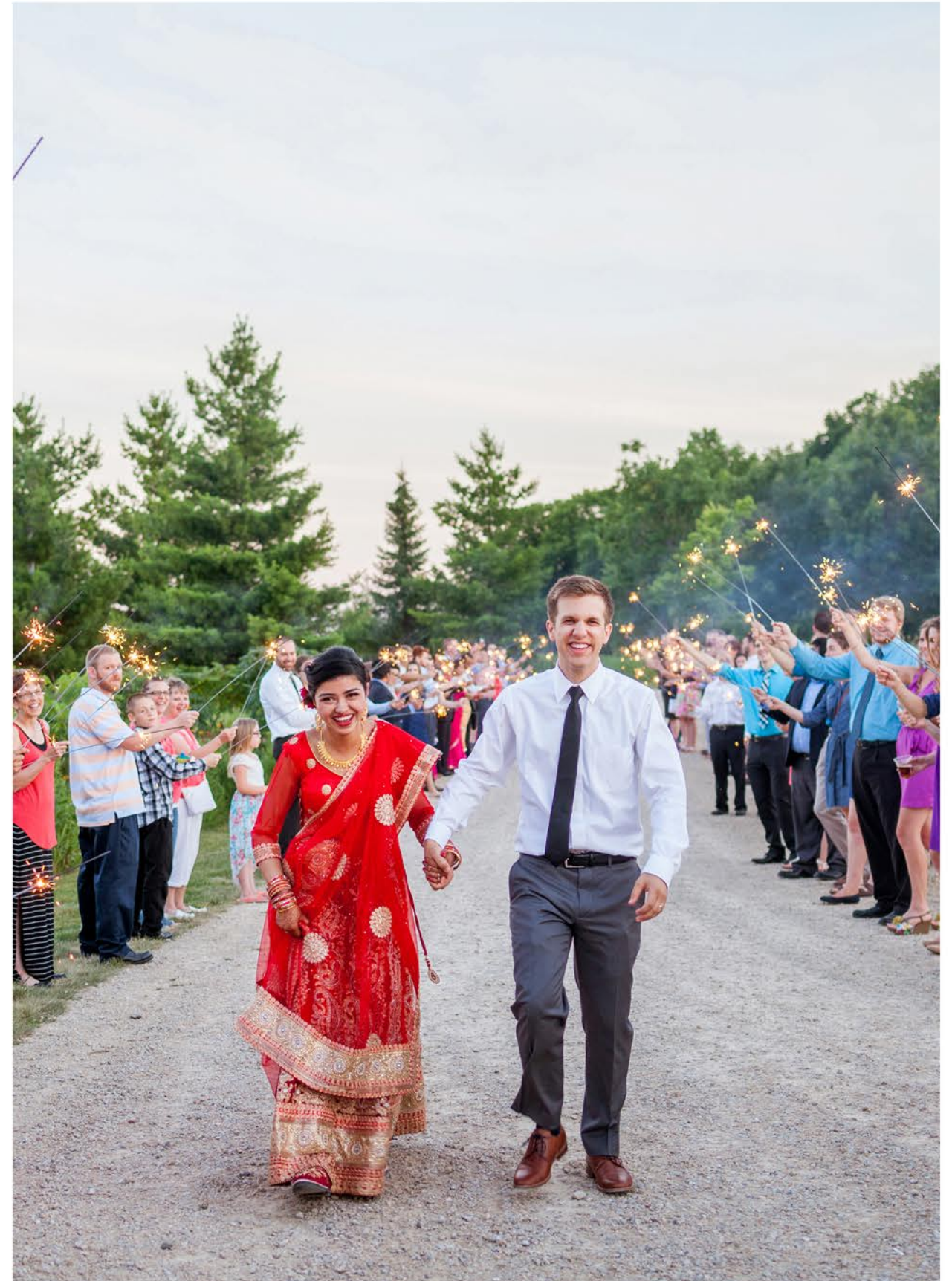

On top of all that her photos are absolutely stunning. She's magical.

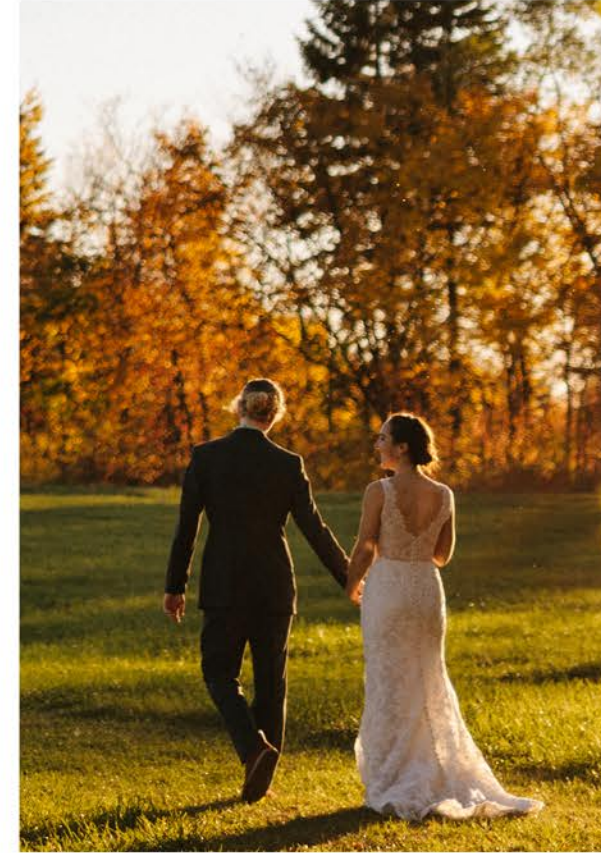

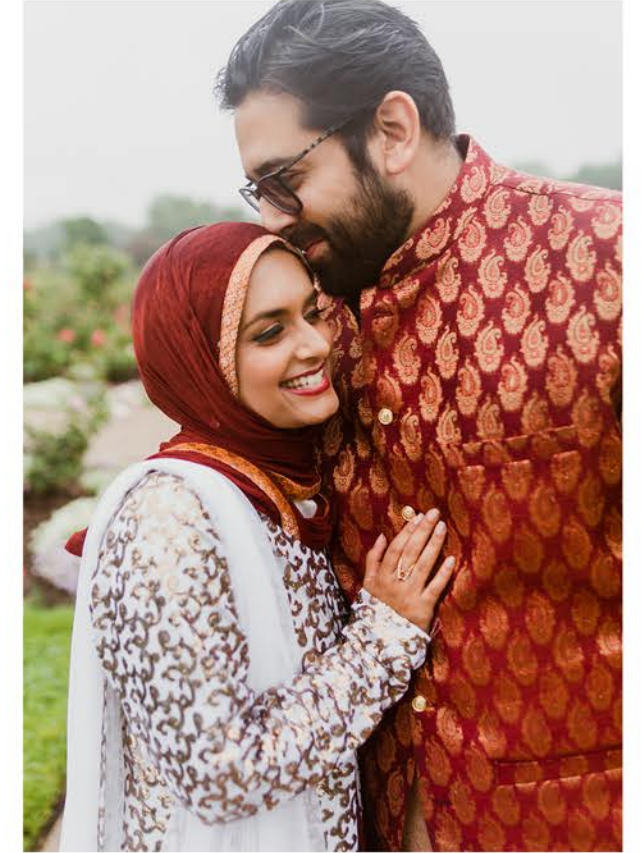
